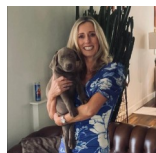

Edinburgh zoo Universal Credit Tickets

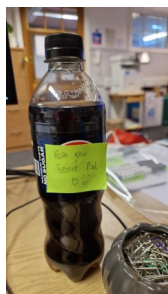
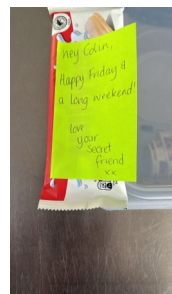
