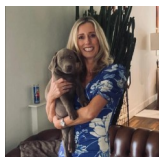

The person they care for may suffer from mental health problems, disability, chronic ill-health and/or drug and alcohol misuse. If you think your child may be a Young Carer, please contact Mrs Robertson (our Young Carer Ambassador) through the school email address. They may be eligible to join 'Edinburgh Young Carers' who organise activities, discussions, support and a chance to meet other young carers and have fun.
