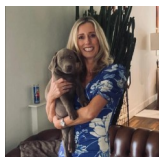

Staff returned back to school on Monday 6/1/25 to undertake a full day of professional learning. We have started to refresh our Royal Mile curriculum rationale. This is where we plan what learning, teaching and assessment will look like in our Royal Mile context to support our pupils to reach their potential.

We also participated in outdoor learning where we learned to make a fire for cooking in Holyrood park, use the trees for Maths and explore how to make good use of our amazing environment for learning, which is on our doorstep.

Pupil support assistants and Nursery staff were trained in 'playboxes'. Playboxes offers opportunities for early play experiences by providing an enthusiastic play partner, a dedicated place and time, and engaging resources designed to interest the child. It is motivating and it is fun. We hope to offer it to children identified as benefitting from it.

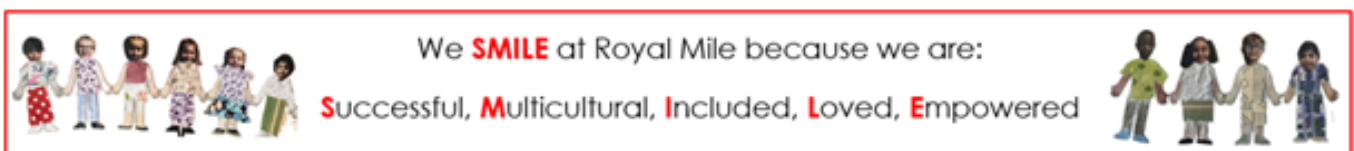
### **New Service Director and Chief Education Officer**
